School overcrowding and boundary problems to be discussed at community forums

Parent, staff task force will submit ideas and seek additional input

A group of parents and district staff members are working to review current school boundaries and look at issues of overcrowding at some schools.

The Comprehensive Boundary Review Task Force, consisting of nine parents and eight staff members, are looking for ways to balance school populations, relieve overcrowding at some schools and ensure that classrooms in all schools are used efficiently.

The group has defined problems at schools where current enrollment exceeds capacity, while

others are underused. Additional problem areas include current boundaries that are fragmented or areas where continued growth is anticipated.

The task force has identified proposed solutions to these problem areas. Solutions proposed include many alternatives. Parents are encouraged to attend the community forums listed below to hear the proposed solutions and offer additional input before any decisions are presented to the School Board.
